

ERRATUM

Since the analysis of the audit data for the HQIP report was completed, the RCOphth NOD have received information that improves the quality of the data received for the audit. If the analysis was updated the sample size would increase as would the percentage of eyes with visual acuity data. These corrections would affect many of the results quoted in the HQIP report, although for the majority of changes the differences would be very small.

The fault with the data extraction for one centre has been rectified and this centre's data will be included in future analysis. In addition, the reported visual acuity results for centre 5 are not accurate, this centre had 42.4% of eyes with a preoperative visual acuity recorded, 62.4% of operations with a postoperative visual acuity recorded and 26.8% of eyes with both a preoperative and postoperative visual acuity recorded. For national deciles of social deprivation results on pages 21 and 22, decile 1 refers to the most deprived decile and decile 10 to the least deprived decile.
