

Cataract Audit data validation - review your data by 12 March 2019

Contributing surgeons and centres must validate their cataract audit data on the NOD Audit website by Tuesday, 12 March 2019

The data analysis has been completed for the third prospective audit data collection period, 01 September 2017 to 31 August 2018. Contributing surgeons and centres can now view their data behind the login on the [NOD audit website](https://www.nodaudit.org.uk) prior to inclusion in the Audit annual report and the Clinical Outcomes Publication.

To view your data, you need to be [registered](#) on the NOD audit website, and if you are already registered to use the NOD website, please log in (<https://www.nodaudit.org.uk/account/login>) with your details and your data will be available for viewing in the “analysis section” of the website. If you are yet to register, please do so with an NHS email or doctors.org email address via this link, <https://www.nodaudit.org.uk/account/register>.

Please note that the data in the search database is for the September 2016 - August 2017 audit period and data for the September 2017 – August 2018 audit period is available for checking in the [analysis section](#) of the NOD website.

The NOD team encourages all contributing surgeons and centres to check their data by **Tuesday, 12 March 2019**, ahead of the report publication. Please inform as many of your colleagues as possible to check their individual data on the NOD audit website, <https://www.nodaudit.org.uk/analysis>. **If we do not hear back from you by 12 March 2019, we will assume you agree that your results are accurate for publication on the NOD website and My NHS website.**
